Q. How do I Apply?

A. You can apply for Social Security and SSI at your local Social Security Office or by telephone or online. You can also schedule an appointment to have one of our attorneys assist you with an online application at our office.

Q. What if I have been denied?

A. Bring your denial letter with you to our office as soon as possible so that we can prepare your appeal.

Q. How much will it cost?

A. There is no fee unless we win your case. The maximum fee set by federal law is 25% of the back pay.
